The Middlesex 3 Coalition is a public / private partnership comprised of private and public leaders working together to improve economic and business development along Route 3 in Middlesex County. The Middlesex 3 Coalition brings stakeholders together to:

- Promote the region, resources, and businesses,
- Advocate and improve transportation facilities, services and mobility,
- Connect employee readiness and workforce development resources with businesses in the region,
- Improve expedited permitting and infrastructure capacity,
- Identify and promote real estate development parcels and encourage readiness,

- Promote healthcare access and affordability.

Middlesex 3 works closely with regional business, municipal, state, federal, educational, real estate and community leaders. Middlesex 3 hosts a series of stakeholder meetings, which focus on the M3 target areas and priorities, including transportation, education and workforce development, healthcare, housing, permitting and infrastructure improvements, and real estate development. These are member-only meetings and provide an opportunity to discuss economic development programs and policies that impact our region's business climate. **Middlesex 3 members can attend these meetings at no cost.**

3. Receive updates on economic development initiatives happening in the M3 region.

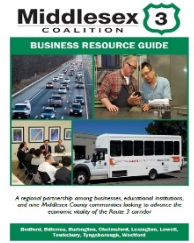
